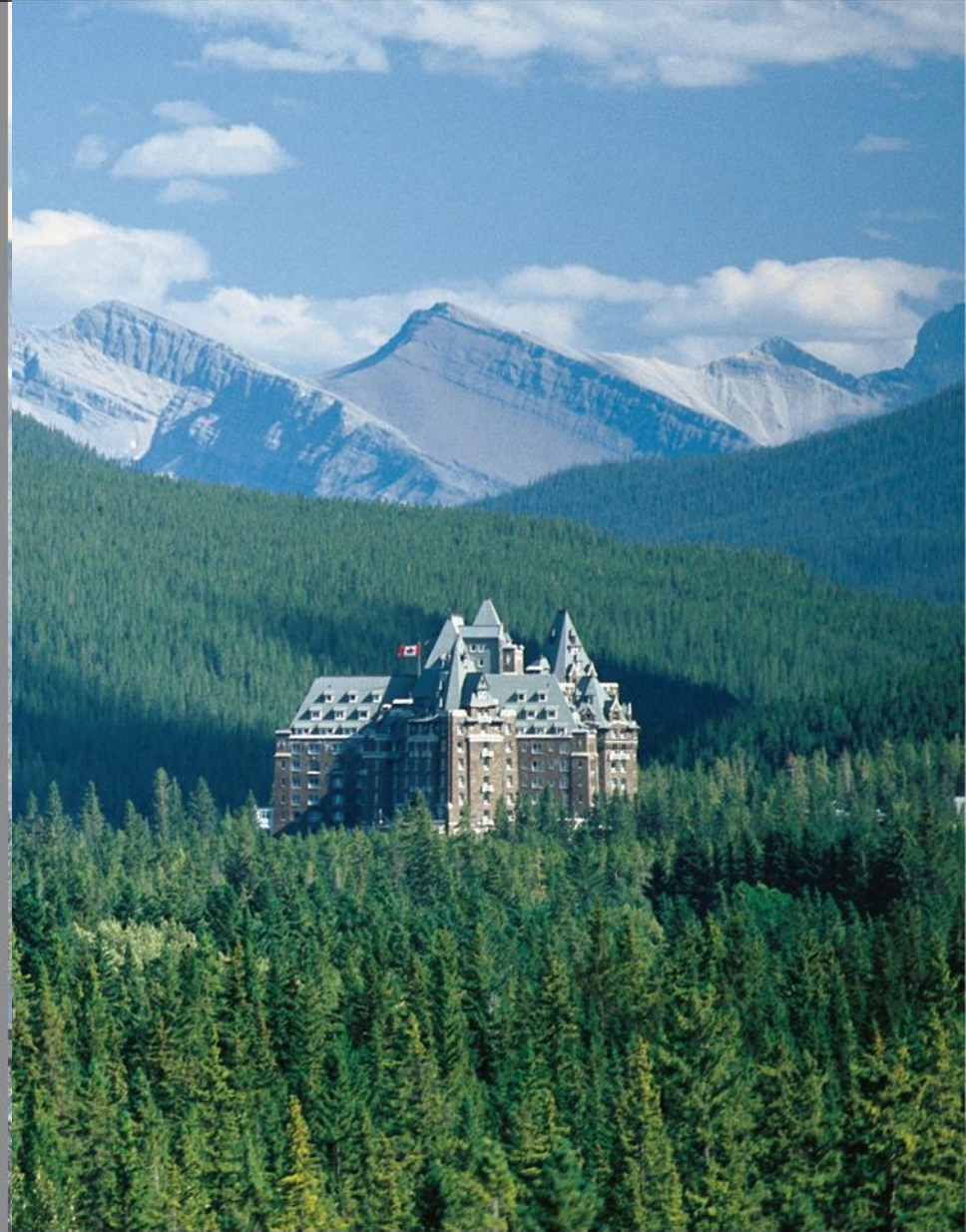

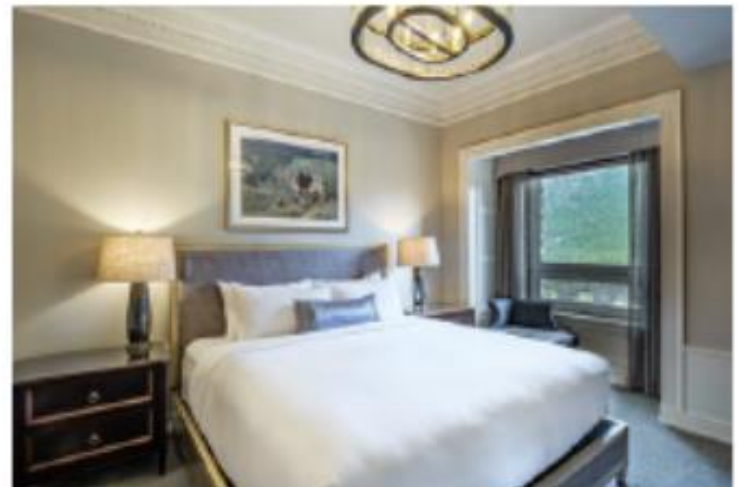




SIGNATURE SUITES

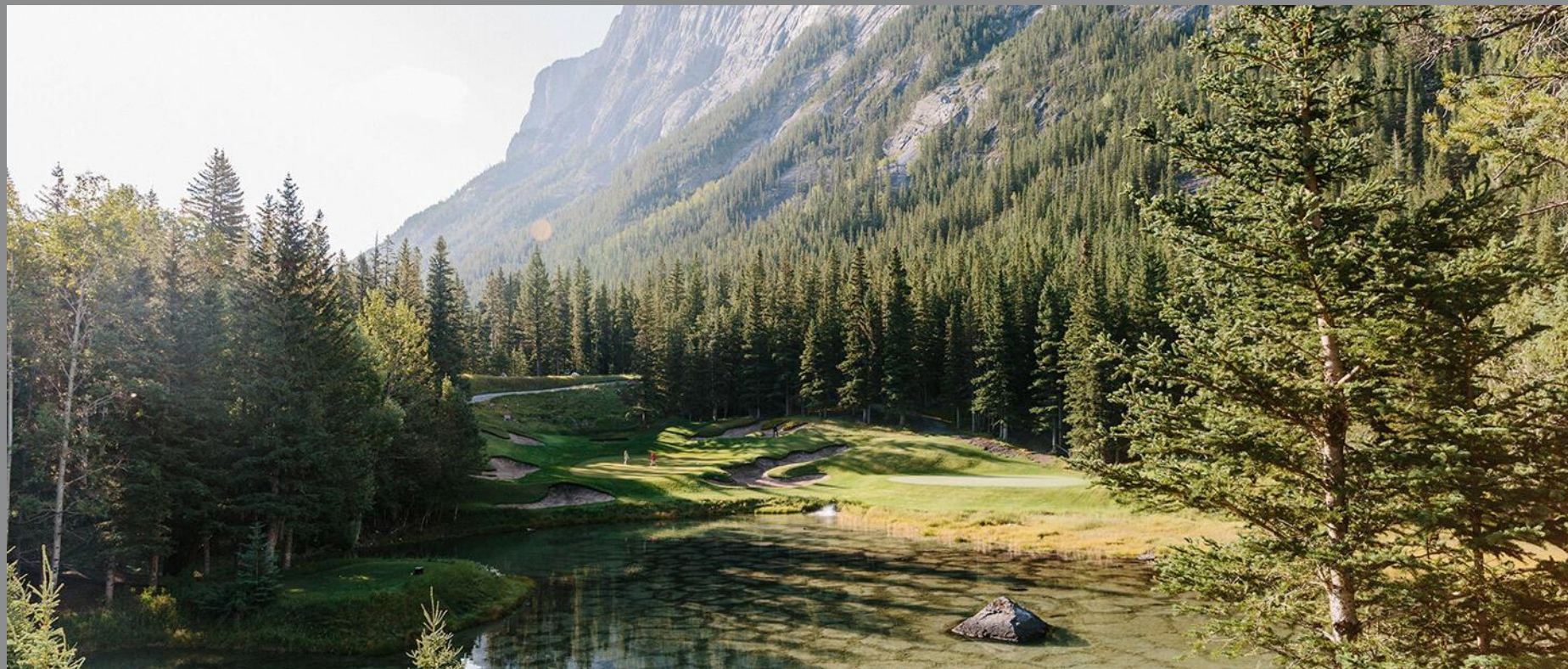
